

Eye Check-up, Treatment and Awareness Camp Conducted for Senior Citizens at IAEA HQ

An Outreach and Extension activity in the form of an eye check-up, treatment, and awareness camp was conducted on 3.6.2026 at the IAEA HQ exclusively for senior citizens, from 9:00 a.m. to the late afternoon. The camp saw active participation from more than 150 senior citizens from the nearby Anna Nagar J.J. Camp community and Sanjay Nagar camp, who benefitted from the services provided.



Anna Nagar community members, along with residents from Sanjay Nagar camp, attended the program as part of the extension initiative aimed at improving eye health awareness and early detection of vision-related issues among the elderly.



The camp was organised in collaboration with Venu Eye Hospital and Research Centre, which provided medical expertise, screening services, and treatment support during the event.

The programme was inaugurated by Shri Suresh Khandelwal, General Secretary, in the presence of Prof. S.Y. Shah, Patron, Prof. Rajesh, Director I/c and other dignitaries. Senior citizens present at the camp

appreciated the initiative, which focused on preventive eye care, diagnosis, and guidance for further treatment wherever required.
